That makes the fabric last longer, reduces power consumption and prevents the surface of the iron from getting

Directions for use: Turn the nozzle on the front a quarter turn. Set the iron to the right temperature for the type of textile being ironed. Gently shake HG "ironing spray", hold the bottle at a slight angle and spray the fabric from a distance of about 20 cm. Slightly moisten the fabric (moisten only very slightly for silk and wool). Then iron the laundry straight away until the desired result is achieved. Treat stubborn folds and creases twice. Turn the nozzle a quarter-turn after use (OFF).

Attention: Transport and store the bottle upright. Protect from frost.
